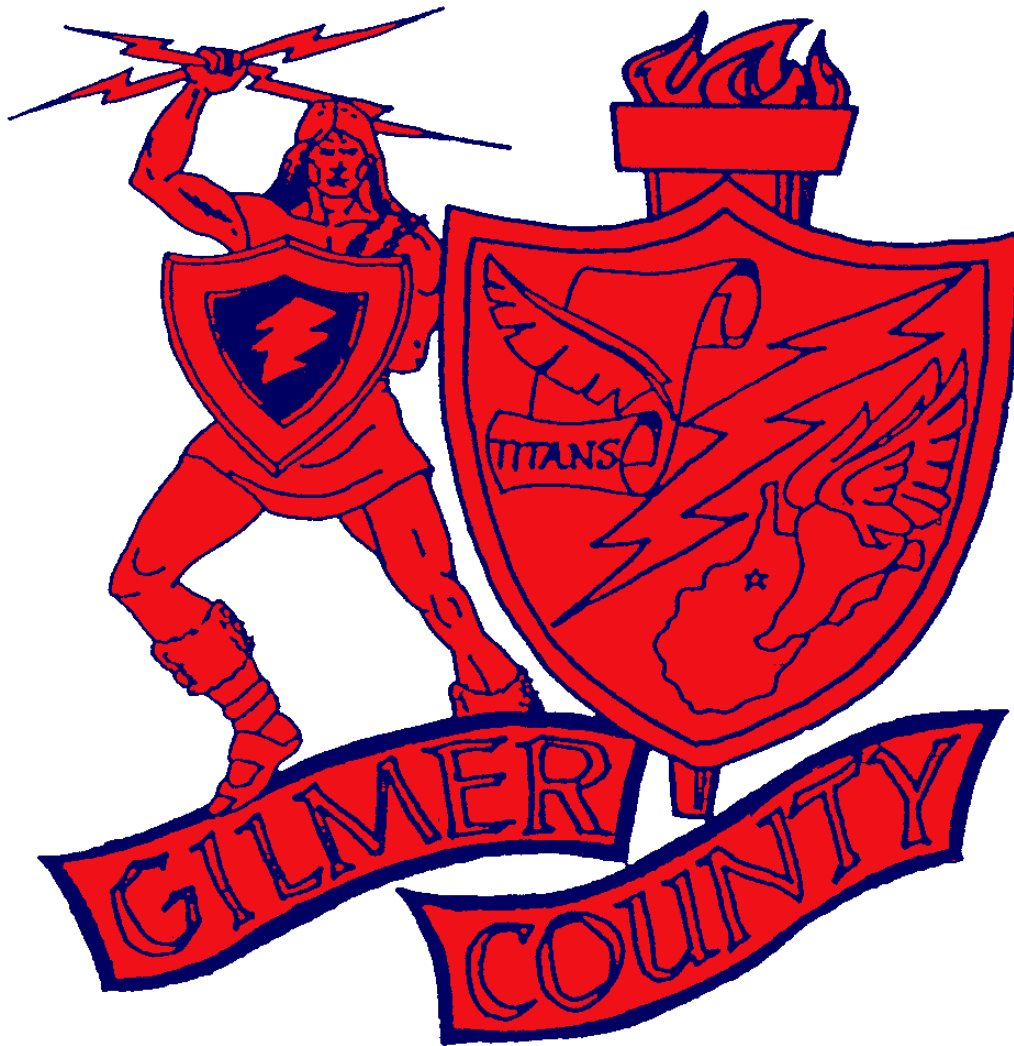

A Brief History of Football in Gilmer County

Glenville Normal School – now Glenville State College – fielded the first scholastic football team in Gilmer County during the fall of 1908. At that time there were no public high schools in the county, so students interested in furthering their education attended Glenville Normal's prep school, which later became Glenville High School. As was typical in that day, it's entirely possible that some of these high school students played on GSC's early football teams.

In 1922, the citizens of Glenville District established the county's first public high school at Sand Fork. That same fall, SFHS fielded the county's first high school football team. The team seems to have been short-lived, however, and the results of only one game could be located.

Five years later, in 1927, both Tanner and Troy High Schools established football teams. Troy apparently played no games, but Tanner managed to play relatively full schedules for several years. Tanner was a member of the Little Mountaineer League from 1930 until dropping the football program after the 1934 season. Though the Bulldogs didn't win many games in the program's eight-year history, a few alumni went on to greater success in state high school circles. Bill Moore, who played on THS's initial team in 1927, later guided Oak Hill to the state championship game in 1950. Merrill Gainer, THS class of 1933, went on to coach at Big Creek, Bluefield and Patrick Henry (VA) High Schools. Gainer won 4 state titles at Bluefield and added another at Patrick Henry.

In 1930, Glenville State turned Glenville High School over to the city's board of education, and GHS fielded its first football team that fall. GHS went on to field a team every year of the school's existence.

Normantown decided to enter gridiron competition in the fall of 1934, the only season in which three county teams fielded football teams. The Vikings uniforms were made up of an assortment of odds and ends from other area high schools as well as GSC. Cam Henderson (Davis & Elkins), Nate Rohrbough (GSC), Pete Rogers (Tanner High) and Red Wilfong (Glenville High) all donated equipment and shoes to the fledgling team. When Tanner elected to discontinue its football team at the end of the season, Coach Rogers sold all of Tanner's uniforms to Normantown.

Glenville and Normantown both became members of the Central West Virginia Conference in the early 1930s. Normantown dropped football after the 1939 season, leaving GHS as the county's only high school football team. During the 1940s, 50s and 60s, boys from the county's four other high schools were allowed to attend GHS and play football, so long as they arranged their own travel to Glenville or met one of the buses that traveled to GHS. All five high schools joined the Little Kanawha Conference in 1953 and remained dual members of the CWVC and LKC until consolidation.

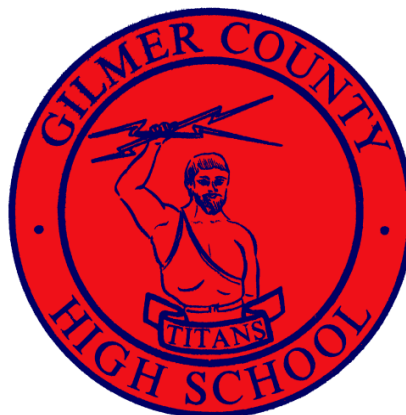
By the late 1960s, county enrollment had dwindled to the point that the decision was made to consolidate the county's remaining schools into the new Glenville High School building. Tanner had closed its doors after the 1961-62 school year, and the other four schools closed in 1968 to make way for the new Gilmer County High School. With the opening of GCHS, all Gilmer County boys were given the opportunity to play high school football for the first time.

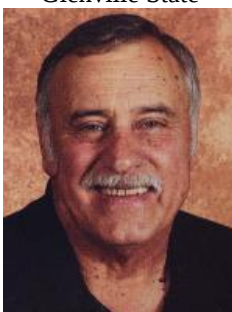

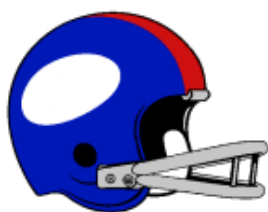

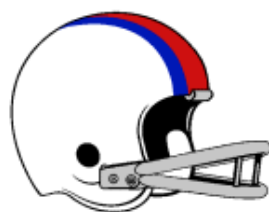

**Sand Fork Lions**

Sand Fork was the first high school in Gilmer County to field a football team. The Lions initiated the grid sport in 1922 and played at least one game, a 34-0 loss to Weston's JV on November 1 in Weston. The *Clarksburg Telegram* article concerning this game is

the only record of Sand Fork football that has survived, and it is doubtful that the school sponsored a team after this initial year.

**Troy Trojans**

Troy High School appears to have dabbled in football in the late 1920s. Former Titan coach Damon West – an early THS graduate – recalled that the boys practiced frequently in the early days but quite possibly played no games. Indeed, two scheduled games were located

in the *Parkersburg News* – a home contest against Tanner on 10/1/1927 and a 10/5/1929 game at Cedarville – but there is no record that those or any other games were actually played.

Football Fields

**Rohrbaugh Field**

Rohrbaugh Field was the long-time home of the football teams of Glenville State, Glenville High and Gilmer County High. The field was named for Edward G. Rohrbaugh, principal/president of Glenville State from 1908 to 1942.

The land for Rohrbaugh Field was purchased by Glenville Normal School in the early 1920s. In the early days, the Pioneers apparently played at various locations in an around Glenville. Games in 1922 and 1923 were held at Hays Field, a venue that apparently lacked bleachers. The first few games of the 1924 season were held at the Gilmer County Fair Grounds.

The October 25, 1924 game versus West Liberty – a scoreless tie – was the first held at the newly completed Rohrbaugh Field. The following year, bleachers were completed and the field was dedicated on October 19 against Slippery Rock, a 14-12 win.

When Glenville High fielded its first football team in 1930, the Red Terrors were allowed to use Rohrbaugh Field and continued to do so all through the program's existence. By the time GHS began using the field, it had been given its current name.

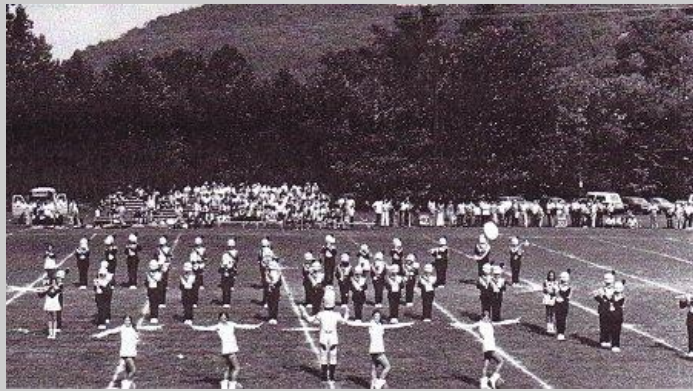
The first major renovation to Rohrbaugh came in 1948, when the bleachers were expanded and a new field house was constructed. Work ran into the high school season, so Glenville's home game against Calhoun County on September 10 had to be switched to Grantsville. Construction delays in 1950 forced GSC to play part of its home schedule in Grantsville.

The Pioneers and Red Terrors shared Rohrbaugh Field for several decades. However, when Gilmer County High School consolidated in 1968, there were conflicts with the college over the use of the field. GCHS played one lone game at Rohrbaugh Field – the Homecoming contest against Gassaway – before occupying their own field the following year.

Glenville State was the sole occupant of Rohrbaugh Field from 1970 to 1977, when the Pioneers occupied a brand new stadium on Mineral Road. In 1980, the college turned Rohrbaugh Field over to Gilmer County Schools, and the Titans moved all of its games back to the venerable old field. The high school installed lights at Rohrbaugh Field that fall, an improvement GSC backers had requested for decades. The Titans defeated Calhoun County on August 29, 1980 in the first night game ever held on Rohrbaugh Field. The Titans continued to use the field until 2001, when all games were moved to GSC's newly renovated Morris Stadium.

Terror Field

In 1950, Gilmer County Schools purchased a lot on Walnut Street adjacent to Pine Manor addition to use as an athletic field. Grading and other work was done on the field that fall, and there was hope that Glenville High would be able to hold varsity games on the field in 1951. However, the field never saw varsity action and was only ever used for practice. The field was apparently a very hard surface and former players remember having to clear it of rocks before every practice. The purchase was not a total loss, though. The new Glenville High School – now Gilmer County High – was constructed on the land.



September 3, a 14-12 win against Calhoun County.

When GSC turned Rohrbough Field over to Gilmer County Schools in 1980, GCHS discontinued the use of VanHorn Field and moved back to the old field permanently. With the exception of a single game at Pioneer Field in 1978, GCHS played all of its home games from 1969 through 1979 at VanHorn Field, compiling an 18-32 record there.

VanHorn Field

Following a conflict with GSC over the use of Rohrbough Field in 1968, Gilmer County High realized it would have to secure an alternate site for its games. GCHS's new field was constructed just off of Vanhorn Drive in Hays City (currently the vacant lot across Route 5 from the Foodland Plaza) and opened on September 26, 1969, a 27-6 loss to Doddridge County. The Bulldogs' Jim Merritt scored the first touchdown at the field by hauling in a 56-yard pass from quarterback Rick Barton. Bill Turner was the first Titan to score at the new field, catching a 49-yard pass from Tom Lilly in the same game.

Lights were installed at VanHorn Field in 1976, and the first night game in Gilmer County history was played on



Stadium for 25 years. Gilmer County High played a lone game at the stadium in 1978 – a 21-8 loss to Calhoun County – but used its own VanHorn Field and Rohrbough Field for the remainder of the 20th Century.

In 2001, Pioneer Stadium was renamed Morris Stadium in honor of Ike and Sue Morris, who had funded major renovations to the field. Morris had donated the funds with the stipulation that GCHS be allowed to use the field as well, so in the fall of that year the Titans moved out of old Rohrbough Field and made Morris Stadium their permanent home. The Titans and Pioneers have shared the stadium ever since.

Morris Stadium

Glenville State College began making plans for a new football stadium in the early 1970s. Rohrbough Field had served Pioneer football faithfully for decades, but it routinely flooded, wreaking havoc with the schedule.

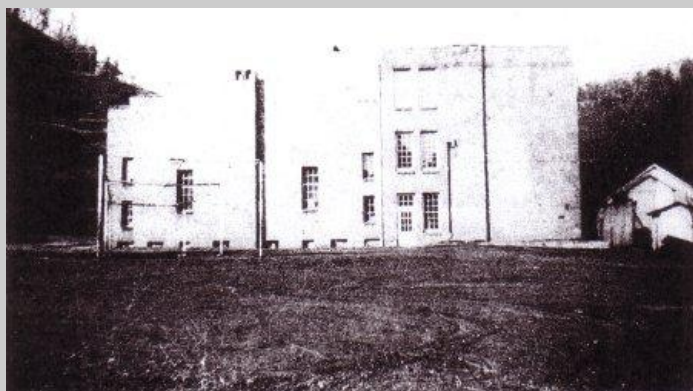
The new field on Mineral Road opened on September 10, 1977 with a 38-7 loss to Gardner-Webb. Lee Hodges scored the first touchdown in the new stadium on a 1-yard run in the first quarter. This game marked the first time GSC hosted a night game (the high school began doing so the year before on its own field). On October 22, the field was officially dedicated as Pioneer Stadium during the game against West Liberty.

The Pioneers remained the sole occupant of Pioneer

Other County Venues

Tanner High School was the first county high school to field a full-fledged football team in 1927. The team practiced and played its games on the field located behind the school, seen pictured to the left.

Normantown's football team played on the field behind the school. Due to limited space, the field was only 80 yards long. This led to some interesting ground rules: Kickoffs, touchbacks, etc. likely had to be adjusted due to the length of the field. Once a team crossed midfield (the 40-yard line) for the first time during its possession, the officials marked the ball back 20 yards to simulate a 100-yard field. However, if a ball carrier broke away and ran into the end zone untouched, the score was allowed to stand.



No information has survived on where the short-lived teams representing Sand Fork or Troy played.

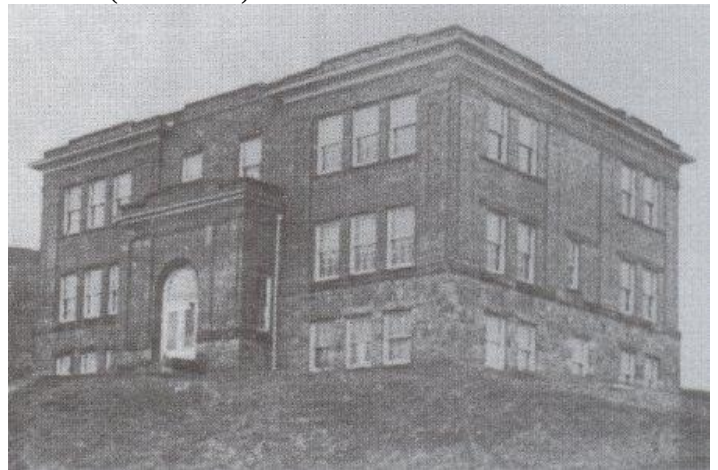
